Minutes of the previous meeting

Officers Reports -

Chair - Simon Degler

Firstly I'd like to offer my apologies for not being able to attend but I am with my lad this weekend as Claire has gone away. Believe me she tried to arrange for another weekend, but it was not possible.

Again I'd like to thank all the County Officers for all the work they put into the running of CCAA. Because of their efforts my job becomes very easy.

Thanks again to Chris as Tournament organiser for running all the shoots and helping us make some money which supports the spending on things like the hall hire for Squad sessions and travel to conferences etc. where necessary so that people aren't out of pocket when on official business. Shoots this year have been well-attended, with the County Outdoor event being the largest I've seen for many years. Chris is looking to stand down from the Tournament Organiser's role after many years of service, however so far there are no names forthcoming although Chris has said that he is happy to assist during the first year to give an extended handover. We now have many tournaments (Target, Clout and now Flight) throughout the calendar and have made Penrith the main venue for the events. This helps with attracting archers from out of the County due to the ease of access via the main roads. As a suggestion the role could be potentially split between two people. One could take on Target shoots whereas someone else could take on the Clout and Flight shoots. This is just a suggestion if someone out there feels the role to be too daunting to do on their own seeing the number of events which are put on over the year.

Squad sessions are generally well attended (there have been a couple of exceptions where there have been clashes, but that can be expected). There has certainly been a better regular turn out than there has been in previous years (like when I was Squad Manager), so it is encouraging to see that archers are looking to better themselves and use the Squad sessions to that end. Also with Ru and Malcolm running compound specific days we are better catering for the compound archers within the County and providing support where possible.

Congratulations to Alan Wills who managed to win a Bronze medal at the European Field Championships in Poland this summer. Alan had the top score after the first two days before the

knockout stages (so he was the 'real' champion). Alan also scored the top score in the BA Postal League for (I think) the 7th year running. Well done. Alan is still an inspiration to us all.

Chairman's note: did NCAS award Alan £100 for representing GB and similarly did CCAA match that £100 as we have done in the past? (See Note 1 in Matters Arising below.)

Commiserations to Ru who came 4th at the World Field Champs in Hungary (EFAA/WFAA? – not sure which ruling body). (See Note 2 in Matters Arising below.)

Chairman's note again: I understand that NCAS would not fund Ru as it's not an Archery GB/World Archery event, but should CCAA make a donation seeing as she represented GB at an international event? Something to consider and debate at the meeting. (See Note 3 in Matters Arising below.)

Thanks also go to Jim for the work he's put in to starting off new clubs and introducing more members to the sport. Not only is he widening the interest having more County members helps to bring in more revenue from annual subs and potential tournament entries.

I am willing to stand for another year should the rest of the Committee be happy that I do so.

We held a County Committee meeting on 8th February. Minutes and actions were distributed following that meeting. The main topics of discussion at the February meeting were to accept the amendments to the Constitution, and to vote-in the County Coaching Organiser, County Squad Manager, and Junior Officer.

I have attended NCAS Committee Meeting on 24th January, 28th March, 9th May and 14th November and the AMG on 28th March. The Minutes of all meetings are circulated by email, as soon as they are available.

I am happy to continue as County Secretary for another year.

Treasurer - Chrissey Burnett

We have made a profit during 2014-15.

Membership fee income appears to have decreased; this is due to timing of receiving and banking affiliation cheques at the end of the year 2014-15.

Shoot income is up again thanks to Chris's efforts providing well supported County competitions.

Expenditure has also gone up due to Archers expenses for two intercounty shoots both based in Yorkshire; costs associated with County held shoots (in line with 2012-13); Officers expense includes costs for Alf Davies trophy.

Coaching costs are less as no level 1 or 2 courses have been funded this year and the cost being from Squad training days.

County Coaching Organiser - Gary Pimblett

The level 1 Coaching course I was organising had to be cancelled after four people pulled out. I am hoping to re-organise this course. I have four people on the waiting list, but it needs a minimum of eight people to run. I will need the course fee upfront!

I can run a Level 2 course if there is enough demand.

The renewal process has started. The Renewal Panel needs Level 2 Coaches, so I am finding out what else needs to be done so that we can run these ourselves, without relying on Coaches from other Counties.

Tournament Organiser - Chris Battersby

It has been a good year. All the tournaments made a profit. There was an increase in overall numbers but there was a decrease in the number of Juniors.

I am receiving entries by email and on Facebook, but I am not receiving the money. The hall costs £453; so it needs 28 archers to cover the costs. The Indoor shoots can only take 64 archers. Archers who don't turn up, often haven't sent their entry fee. These are mostly from inside the County!

Could I ask for people to help set-up? This time there were only two people and their partners.

It was proposed during that this request is put out, two weeks before the next shoot. They would be asked to assemble on the Saturday evening, before the shoot. It doesn't have to be people who will be shooting. Also ask for someone at lunchtime, to help changing targets.

It was also proposed that we could employ local people to help, but that wasn't thought a good idea because of the tax and insurance.

County Squad Manager - Ru Lochlea

No report.

County Records - Craig Benson

2015 has been a bumper year for county records, with several archers setting records then beating them later in the year, there have been 86 in total, 47 for the juniors, 39 for the seniors.

Cumbria is unique within the Northern Counties in that we are the only county, where the records officer looks through results to check for records for archers, all the other counties require the archers to claim themselves by filling in a form and submitting it to the records officer, we are also the only county that allows archers to claim records from shooting a round with in their club, again the other counties insist that it has to be at an open shoot, this means there will be rounds that never get shot, I personally don't feel either of these encourage archers, so think we adopt a better system, with this in mind there are still lots of unclaimed records, so hopefully this will encourage others to start shooting the rounds, someone has to be the first to claim.

A note on results sheets produced in the county, several archers, mainly juniors have missed out on records this year due to insufficient information on the results sheet, A results sheet needs to contain the round shot, bow style and age group of each archer, for example, 'Western/ U16 junior gents recurve' this may seem obvious but a few do not have all this so checking for records becomes hard if you don't know what round someone has shot or how old they are, Hits, Score and Golds would be good too, along with the archers club.

I will be producing guidance to go on the county website to make it clearer on how to claim a record and what information must be on the results sheet for shoots in 2016 onwards, if the results don't have all the information then sadly that shoot will not be considered for records.

Well done to all that have got a record this year, I am happy to be kept busy with them as it shows archers are setting new standards within the county, please show your certificates to your club mates and hopefully they will be encouraged to shoot rounds and enter tournaments.

Matters arising from County Records report

The committee wanted to record that they all thought that Craig is doing a good job, and providing very nice certificates. Thank you from the committee.

Well done to all the Juniors at the Northern Counties tournament.

NCAS Rep - Chris Battersby

The NCAS Treasurer is trying to reduce the bank balance, to the benefit of every archer in the Region. There are going to be Coaching Workshops set-up. The membership fee has reduced by 50p for Seniors, and 25p for Juniors.

NCAS are funding the purchase of two-way radios and a licence, for Field competitions in the Region.

Some of our archers could stand for positions as officers on the NCAS Committee. This would give Cumbria a bigger voice on the committee.
