Target lists will be available on each day.

Dress regulations as per AGB rule 307.

Shooting will be to Archery GB/World Archery rules. The judges' word is final.

This is a world record status shoot and will be liable to drug testing. Competitors approached to give samples must comply; if they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Written parental consent must be provided for JUNIORS if asked to comply.

Impairments: Archers with a physical impairment: Please inform the organiser if using a wheelchair, stool or perch, and whether you wish to remain on the shooting line or require a non-shooting target assistant to verify your end score and collect your arrows.

GDPR: When you enter this competition, the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers: Scoring systems and other competitors, for example, target lists and results may be published: First name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of birth/Age category, Email address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled Y/N, Disability information supplied. **Your entry confirms permission for this data to be collected.**
